When the Royal Astronomical Society designated the area as a Dark Sky Preserve in 2011, it further confirmed Jasper's dedication to limiting light pollution, and preserving its ideal conditions for dark sky viewing. WHAT IS A DARK SKY PRESERVE?

A Dark Sky Preserve is an area in which no artificial lighting is visible, and active measures are in place to educate and promote the reduction of light pollution to the public and nearby municipalities. Jasper National Park has made a special commitment to protect and preserve the night sky and to reduce or eliminate light pollution in all its forms.

• What Makes Jasper Different?

Jasper National Park is one of 17 designated Dark Sky Preserves in Canada. We are the second largest Dark Sky Preserve in the world, and we are the largest accessible Dark Sky Preserve - meaning there's a town within the limits of the preserve. jasper.travel/darksky
