DAY 1

Morning

Ski Marmot Basin. Located only 20 minutes from town Marmot Basin offers superb skiing for all levels.

Afternoon

Enjoy Jasper's fluffy powder snow and awesome mountain scenery in a guided snowshoe adventure with Sundog Tours, or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

Evening

Chat fireside with a Native Canadian Indigenous Knowledge Keeper; learn stories of the land and feel the heartbeat of traditional drumming and singing with Warrior Women.

DAY 2

Morning

Discover local wildlife. From majestic elk to the elusive lynx, there are always a wide variety of animals to observe in their natural habitats with Sundog Tours or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

Afternoon

Maligne Canyon Icewalk. Explore the depth of this iconic Jasper canyon on a one of a kind winter adventure with Jasper Hikes and Tours, or SunDog Tours.

Take a tour of the world's second largest dark sky preserve in the Jasper Planetarium's 40-seat dome theatre and peer through the largest telescope in the Rocky Mountains after the show.
