ITINERARY 1

AM: Sightseeing and wildlife tour or breeze into the past on a 1939 Jammer Tour, An open-air, historical tour of Jasper and some of its most spectacular locales with Sundog Tours. Max 10 PAX

PM: Sidecar motorcycle tour. Suitable for all ages and abilities

Evening: Under the Alpine Night Sky dinner package. Runs every Saturday in September and October at the Jasper SkyTram

ITINERARY 2

AM: Canadian art exploration at Mountain Galleries followed by local history at the Jasper Yellowhead Museum & Archives

PM: Train journey from Jasper to Dunster Station (12pm) or McBride Station (9:30am). Guided drive back to Jasper included.

Evening: Experience the Great Out S'mores dining with Jasper Event Management, followed by dark sky and stargazing experience with Jasper Planetarium or Jasper Star Trails

ITINERARY 3

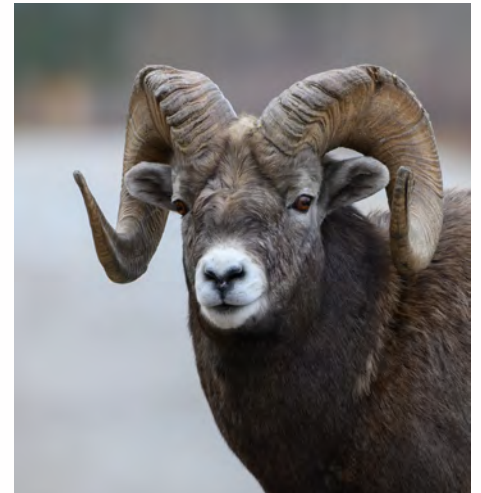
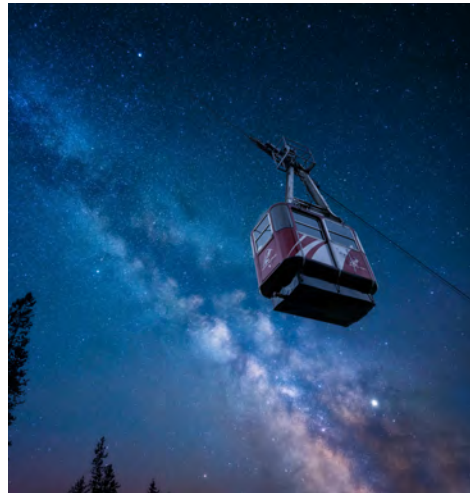
AM: Guided hiking experience. Available with step-on guides for big groups
