ITINERARY 1

AM: Maligne Canyon Icewalk, wildlife & sightseeing tour.
PM: Lunch at Maligne Canyon Wilderness kitchen, along with chat fireside with a native Canadian Indigenous.
Evening: Fine dining at Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge, followed by dark sky and stargazing experience with Jasper Planetarium or explore Jasper's night sky in a telescope tour into the wilderness with Jasper Star Trails.

ITINERARY 2

AM: Dog sledding experience.
PM: Wapukwanis Plant Walk with a native Canadian Indigenous Knowledge Keeper or skate at Mildred Lake or on Pyramid Lake
Evening: Lakeside dining at The Pines Restaurant.

ITINERARY 3

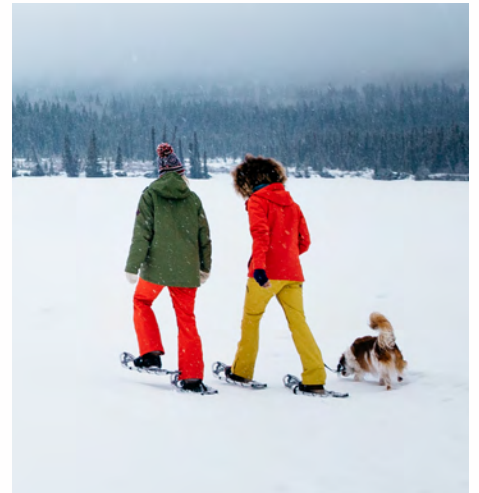
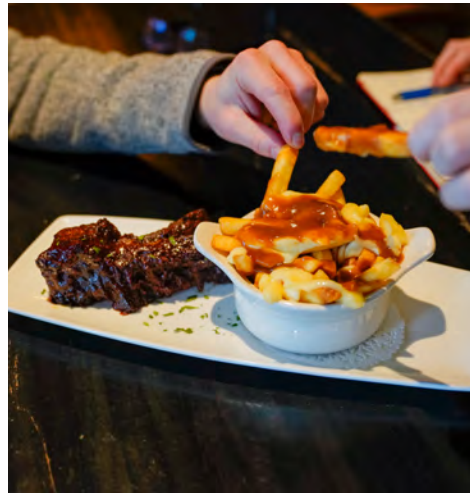
All-day: Full-day skiing or snowboarding at Ski Marmot Basin, followed by Après-ski.

PM: Snow train journey from Jasper to Dunster or McBride Stations and guided drive back to Jasper or pedal your way through the snow on a guided FAT biking experience. Max 10 PAX per guide, suitable for all abilities.
Evening: Experience the Great Out-S'mores, a Canadian dining experience that can be customized for any sized group as a buffet, plated dinner, or reception with Jasper Event Management
