

# 2-Day Winter

**Group Itinerary** 

### DAY 1

### **Morning**

Ski Marmot Basin. Located only 20 minutes from town Marmot Basin offers superb skiing for all ability levels.

#### Afternoon

Pedal your way through the snow on a guided FAT biking experience. Max 10 PAX per guide, suitable for all abilities. or join a winter wildlife tour. Learn about Jasper's varied fauna and how they fit into the National Park's rich ecosystem with Sundog Tours or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

### **Evening**

Jasper Planetarium and Telescope Experience. Take a tour of the world's largest accessible dark sky preserve in the Jasper Planetarium's 40-seat dome theatre and peer through the largest telescope in the Rocky Mountains after the show, or explore Jasper's night sky in a telescope tour into the wilderness with Jasper Star Trails.

## DAY 2

### Morning

Maligne Canyon Icewalk. Explore the depth of this iconic Jasper canyon on a one of a kind winter adventure.

#### Afternoon

Jasper Food Tours will be your friendly host on a 1.5 km Downtown Foodie Tour where you will visit four local restaurants and taste four carefully handpicked dishes paired with boozie treats.

### **Evening**

Chat fireside with a Native Canadian Indigenous Knowledge Keeper; learn stories of the land and feel the heartbeat of traditional drumming and singing with Warrior Women.
