

CULINARY IDEAS



Food Tour

There's no better way to start your culinary journey in the Canadian Rockies than with Jasper Food Tours. Their flagship Downtown Foodie experience is the perfect overview of Jasper's food scene and combines a walk around town, local stories and history, and a sampling of delicious food and drink with an emphasis on local products.

Breakfast

Start your day at Terra, locally farmed and foraged fare is at the heart of what they do. Like the seasons, their menus are constantly changing to incorporate natural, local ingredients. No matter the time of year, they always offer something new and unexpected.

Casual stops

Want delicious food without getting fancied up? Jasper has both sit-down and take-away options. Find fresh sandwiches, juicy burgers or fudge made just for you – often served with a story. Pizza is a popular local choice; Famoso Pizzeria offers authentic Neapolitan style pies and sangria by the pitcher, and Jasper Pizza Place has a hugely diverse menu that's best enjoyed on their roof-top patio.

For an elevated dining experience without the stuffiness, eat at one of Jasper's celebrated local establishments, like the luxurious Fairmont Jasper Park Lodge, The rugged and refined Terra, the scenic Pines Restaurant, Evil Dave's Grill or the unique Maligne Canyon Wilderness Kitchen. You can also enjoy a cabin-in-the-woods experience with a creative Canadian-based meal at Tekarra Restaurant you will not soon forget.

Pints and glasses

The Jasper Brewing Company is almost a mandatory stop for craft beer enthusiasts. This locally owned and operated spot serves the best brews around (their 'Jasper the Bear Ale' is a popular favourite) and upscale pub food. For more of a cocktail experience, Terra has many boozy concoctions and top shelf spirts with their mountain inspired cocktails.

Romantic dinner

Savour your relationship while savouring the delicious Rocky Mountain cuisine at one of Jasper's great restaurants. From cute and casual patio brunch to comfortable elegance with exquisite game meats, there's so much to taste and enjoy in the Jasper food scene. Hot tip: The Pines restaurant at Pyramid Lake Resort is giving out roses to every couple that dines there for dinner on Valentine's Day.
