### DAY 1

### DAY 2

#### Morning

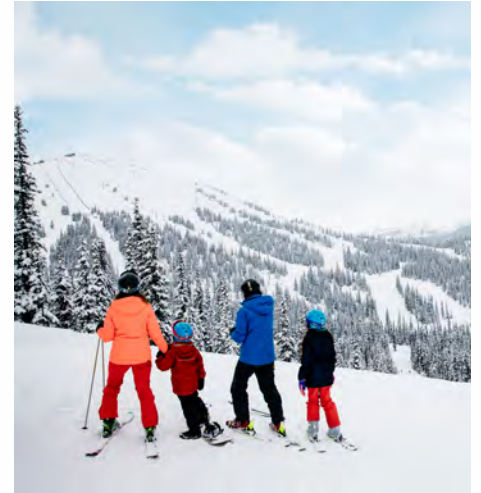
