DAY 1

Morning

Wapakwanis Plant Tour or fireside chat with a Native Canadian Indigenous Knowledge Keeper; learn stories of the land and feel the heartbeat of traditional drumming and singing with Warrior Women.

Experience the history of the region by exploring the Jasper Yellowhead Museum & Archives. You can also wander through town to see historical landmarks such as the Mystery Rock, the Two Brothers Totem Pole and Locomotive 6015.

Learn how to rock climb in a picturesque environment on beginner-friendly rock walls outside in the beautiful Canadian Rockies with Rokaboo Mountain Adventures or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

See Jasper National Park like never before-on a helicopter tour! Get a close-up view of snow-capped peaks and the otherworldly colours in alpine lakes and the Athabasca River. Remote Helicopters offers 20, 30 and 60 minutes flights. Suitable for all ages.

Explore the spectacular scenery of the Maligne Valley; enjoy a cruise or be led on a 3 to 4-km interpretive nature walk at the world-famous Maligne Lake with Maligne Adventure or Sundog Tours.
