Morning

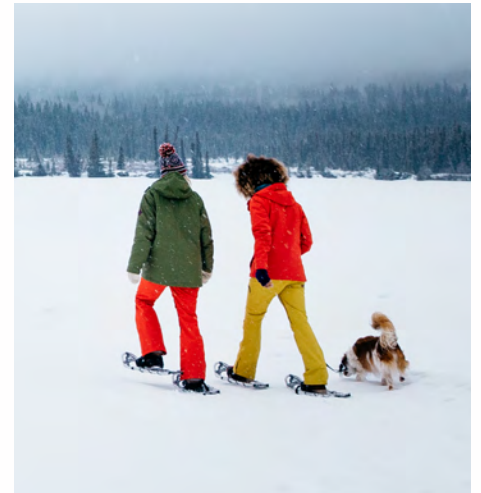
