

WINTER FAMILY FUN

Mittened memories last a lifetime in Jasper, where amazing winter activities await for the whole family.



DAY 1

Morning

Hit the slopes at Ski Marmot Basin for panoramic mountain views and a wide variety of runs, from novice to expert.

Afternoon

Pedal your way through the snow on a guided FAT biking experience. Max 10 PAX per guide, suitable for all abilities or explore local history at the Jasper Yellowhead Museum & Archives. You can also wander through town to see historical landmarks such as the Mystery Rock, the Two Brothers Totem Pole and Locomotive 6015.

Evening

Take a tour of the world's second largest dark sky preserve in the Jasper Planetarium's 50-seat dome theatre and peer through the largest telescope in the Rocky Mountains after the show.

DAY 2

Morning

The newest winter adventure tour from Wild Current Outfitters offers a choice of ice walk, skating, snowshoeing, cross-country skiing, or learn-to-kite. A campfire, baked treats, hot chocolate, and all necessary equipment are included.

Afternoon

Take a wildlife tour to learn about Jasper's varied fauna and how they fit into the National Park's rich ecosystem with Sundog Tours or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

Evening

Fireside Chat with a Native Canadian Indigenous Knowledge Keeper; learn stories of the land and feel the heartbeat of traditional drumming and singing with Warrior Women.

Climb aboard one of Canada's oldest forms of winter transportation: a dog sled. Cold Fire Creek's friendly Alaskan huskies will charm you as you glide over the snow

Venture to the bottom of the deepest canyon in the park with a guided Maligne Canyon Icewalk from Sundog Tours or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

Hit the trails for a snowy hike with sparkling scenery. Trails options range from easy to intermediate on a guided tour with Sundog Tours or Jasper Hikes & Tours.

Learn about local flora and their significance to Indigenous medicine in an interactive Wapakwanis Plant Walk with Warrior Women.

Explore a great mix of cross-country ski trails from easy to intermediate with a knowledgeable guide. Rentals are available in town at Edge Control.

Take a photo with Jasper the Bear located in Downtown Jasper, a treasured town mascot for both children and adults alike.
