GETTING TO & AROUND JASPER NATIONAL PARK

INTERNATIONAL AIRPORTS

The Calgary International Airport (YYC) is approximately five hours from Jasper.

The Edmonton International Airport (YEG) is approximately four hours from Jasper.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

Sundog Tours offers daily service between Jasper and Edmonton Airport.

CONNECTING JASPER AND BANFF NATIONAL PARK

Brewster Express offers daily service between Jasper, Lake Louise, Banff and Calgary from May to October. Sundog Tours offers year-round service.

BY RAIL

VIA Rail Canada runs year-round to and from Vancouver and Toronto.

Rocky Mountaineer runs seasonally from mid-April to mid-October to and from Vancouver.

ICEFIELDS PARKWAY

The Icefields Parkway, also known as Highway 93, is an epic stretch of road connecting Jasper and Banff National Parks, and Southern Alberta. National Geographic called it the “drive of a lifetime.” Sundog Tours offers year-round service. Drivers should only consider this road in winter months if experienced in snowy conditions.

CAR HIRE

Budget, Avis, and National have offices in Jasper, Calgary & Edmonton International Airports.

SELF-DRIVE TO JASPER

You must purchase a Park Pass if driving to Jasper National Park.

- Calgary | 412 km/255 mi - 5 hrs
- Lake Louise | 233 km/145 mi - 3 hrs
- Banff | 287 km/178 mi - 4 hrs
- Vancouver | 805 km/499 mi - 10 hrs

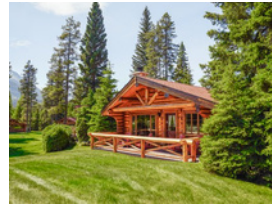
WEATHER

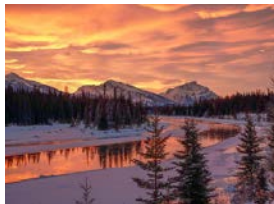

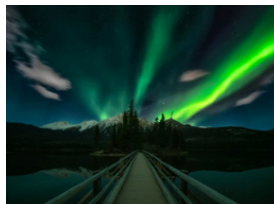

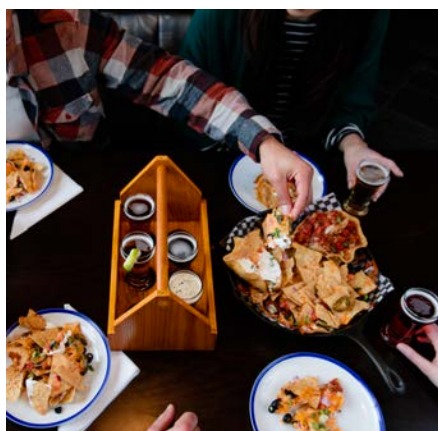
