DAY ONE

Tour the world's second-largest dark sky preserve in [Jasper Planetarium's](#) dome theatre and peer through the largest telescope in the Rocky Mountains after the show, or Explore Jasper's night sky in a telescope tour into the wilderness with [Jasper Star Trails](#).

DAY TWO

Scenic drive through Maligne Valley and visit Jasper's famous Spirit Island. The interpretive [Maligne Lake Cruise](#) is the most comfortable and educational way to see and learn about this world-renowned landmark.
